



History

In the year of 2008, Little Footprints Day Care began at a home setting in the Crocker Amazon area with the vision to teach Mandarin to young child while providing quality care. Within less than a year, capacity reached its maximum capacity of 6. Little Footprints then relocates to the Mission Terrace area and expanded to a large day care of 12 children. With many' ongoing inquiries from parents on the wait list about the space availability, we see the need of finding another site to meet the needs. In the summer of 2011, Little Footprints Preschool opens its door in the Sunset District. Five years passed and Little Footprints Preschool (Sunset) reached its capacity again. In the fall of 2016, Little Footprints Preschool (Ocean View) was born to continue to provide quality care in a 100% Mandarin immersion setting.
